

# Tournament Rules and Information

July 24, 2011

Subject to change at anytime

**Rules:** We will be playing the ball down(as it lies) with the following exceptions. All other rulings are as defined within the USGA 2011 rules or Willow Park Club Local rules.

If your ball is on bare patch(dirt) you will be allowed to lift clean and **drop** to the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole. Areas such as dead grass, an old or recent divot or dirt around the bottom of a tree, etc. do not qualify for relief. Once you pick your ball up to start the process you cannot change your mind.

Should there be damage to the green which interferes with your intended line of your putt you may take relief no closer to the hole.

Should there be damage to the green which interferes with the landing and roll out of your intended chip you may take relief no closer to the hole. If however the normal ball flight of the intended chip shot would clear the damage you are not allowed relief.

**Tee Areas :**

A Blue NCGA Disk	Except 9 <sup>th</sup> hole were you play the Blue Balls
B White NCGA Disk	Blue Handicap 17+ or Age plus Blue Handicap 80+
C White Ball Marker	Age must be at least 65 plus Blue Handicap 90+
D Red NCGA Disk	

You can move back a tee area but as this may result in more strokes make sure you inform the TC when you turn your score card in.

You are not allowed to move forward a tee area unless you receive approval from the Handicap Chairman or the Tournament Chairman prior to starting your round.

**Closest to the Pin :** All par 3's open to all players.

**Net Flight Competition :** 4 flights paying 6 spots in each flight.

**Team Pink Ball Competition :** 2 flights paying each player on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each flight Pro Shop certificates only
